

Release Notes: WinOMS Version 10.1.1

This document includes enhancements and defects fixed in WinOMS, as Sensei product, version 10.1.1.

Enhancements

The following is a list of enhancements included and issues addressed in WinOMS v10.1.1:

CDT 2026 Code Updates

The CDT 2026 code set is included in WinOMS 10.1.1. The update contains 31 new codes, 15 revisions, and 6 deleted codes.

Processing the Code Set Update

Only users with the appropriate security level permission can perform this function.

Note: The End-User License Agreement (EULA) must be accepted before processing the CDT code update.

Note: The list of CDT codes includes oral surgery codes, as well as codes for other types of practices.

To integrate the updated code set into the software:

1. Select **Utilities > CDT Update > Apply CDT Code Changes**. The Confirm Password window is displayed.
2. Type your password and click **Ok**. The ADA CDT Code License Agreement window is displayed.
3. Click **Agree**. The CDT 2026 Code Update window is displayed. The **Add** tab displays the new CDT codes.
4. Select one of the following:
 - **Process Add** to add the new codes to the procedure code table. For each code, click in the Category, Type of Service, and Place of Service columns and make a selection from the drop-down list.
 - **Skip Add** to skip adding the new codes to the procedure code table.
5. Click the **Change** tab. A list of the procedure codes whose descriptions changed in the new CDT code update is displayed. The codes have two descriptions:
 - A 25-character description that applies to the short description field in the procedure code table.
 - A 40-character description that applies to the long description in the procedure code table.
6. Select one of the following:
 - **Process Changes** to apply all description changes.
 - **Skip Changes** to skip updating descriptions in the procedure code table.
7. Click the **Delete** tab. All ADA procedure codes that are obsolete are listed on the **Delete** tab.
8. Select one of the following:
 - **Process Delete** to mark all procedure codes in the list as Inactive. Inactive codes can be used, but they do not display in standard lists.
 - **Skip Delete** to skip changing these codes to Inactive status.
9. Click **Ok**. A window is displayed to print the CDT Code Update Summary report.

2026 ICD-10 Code Updates

The ICD-10 Fiscal Year 2026 diagnostic code set update is included in WinOMS v10.1.1.

QuickBooks® 2024 Desktop Certification

WinOMS 10.1.1 is certified for use with QuickBooks Desktop 2024.

Defects and Small Enhancements

The following defects and issues have been addressed in WinOMS v10.1.1:

ePrescriptions Interface “Cannot Save XML File” Error

An issue prompting a “Cannot Save XML File” error when attempting to save usernames and passwords in the ePrescriptions module has been corrected.

Medicaid Group Specialty Taxonomy Codes (Montana, Texas, North Carolina)

In response to Group Taxonomy Code requirements for Montana Medicaid providers, the field **Medicaid Box 52a** has been updated in the **Insurance Plan Data Entry** interface (**Forms/IDs/Notes** tab), for the selection of additional taxonomy codes: **193200000X - Multi-Specialty Group** and **193400000X - Single-Specialty Group**. If data exists in the **Medicaid Box 52a** for a plan, the Taxonomy code should populate in E6A pos 33 an electronic claim and in dental claim box 52a for a paper claim.

Patient EMR Notes Not Available When Provider is Marked Inactive

In issue in which EMR Notes could not be added or viewed from a patient EMR record when the Regular Provider is marked Inactive has been corrected.

Database Connection Error when merging a Digital Form after Updating to v10.0.1.79

An error experienced by Hosted WinOMS users when merging a digital form has been corrected.

Alabama Prescription Form Correction

Prescription forms printed for practices in Alabama now include two signature lines with **Dispense As Written** and **Product Selection Permitted**.

Vermont Prescription Form Correction

Prescription forms printed for practices in Vermont now include the patient’s **Date of Birth** as required.

Insurance Processing Queue in Practice Central

An error in which the Insurance Processing Queue in Practice Central did not refresh has been corrected.

Custom Data Export (Patient Demographics) Not Pulling the Aging Balance Brackets

An error in which the custom data export did not pull aging balance brackets has been corrected.
